Who We Are

Wave has a national reputation for the delivery of outstanding pupil outcomes including enabling pupils to access the most appropriate education setting and transition to employment, training and higher or further education. Our Academies include Alternative, Special and Medical provision. The trust educates over 1000 pupils and employs over 350 members of staff.

Wave aims to improve outcomes and raise the aspirations of young people and their families. We have a long history of success: Over recent years, NEET rates have been consistently below 7%, compared to a sector (PRU NEETS) average of 50% with our 2019/20 figure at 4%. We also boast a 95% rate for leavers achieving at least Level 2 qualification in both English and Maths. As an experienced Trust who work with children and young people with high levels of additional needs, we know what the key aspects of successful education are for the most vulnerable and challenging pupils in society. We believe in a positive, relationship driven, communication friendly and trauma informed educational response. Wave is committed to collaboration and offers a range of consultancy services.

We understand the vital importance of a holistic and multi-disciplinary approach to mental health for our pupils. We are able to ensure that children and families are supported and signposted in order to gain access to a variety of community based provision alongside the Trust's therapeutic approaches and curriculum to promote well-being and to help develop and maintain positive mental health.
